ORDER

WHEREAS by Application filed February 11, 2022, pursuant to section 10 of the *Industrial Relations Act*, the Applicant, Canadian Union of Public Employees, did seek certification as bargaining agent for a unit of employees of the Respondent, Miramichi Youth House Inc., operating as Phoenix House, Miramichi, New Brunswick;

AND WHEREAS the Respondent did file a timely Reply in which it opposed the Application;

AND WHEREAS no opposition was filed by any of the employees affected by the Application, notwithstanding confirmation received by the Board that Notices to Employees were posted;

AND WHEREAS following a virtual pre-hearing conference on March 25, 2022, a two-day virtual hearing was scheduled for May and later adjourned to July 6 and 7, 2022;

AND WHEREAS by correspondence to the Board dated June 9, 2022, the Applicant did request to withdraw the within Application, the Respondent consenting to same;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Labour and Employment Board does hereby **GRANT** the request to **WITHDRAW** the Application for Certification filed by Canadian Union of Public Employees.
